



## HOW TO: THE TEAM SCRAMBLE

You may have families that bring multiple adults and juniors on their team. In order to maximize playing opportunities, consider offering the below scoring options.

Example: One Pair  
Team Score: 3



Example: Two Pairs  
Team Score: 2



Example: Three Pairs  
Team Score: 3



### NOTES

- As a reminder, pairs must have one adult and one junior playing at all times.
- The pair with the lowest score will count as the overall team score.

### TERMS TO KNOW!

TERMS TO KNOW!	
<b>Scramble</b>	PGA Family Cup format where both players on a team hit drives. The best shot is selected, and each player plays from that selected spot. This process continues until the ball is holed.
<b>Adult</b>	Team member that is 18 or older.
<b>Junior</b>	Team member that is 17 or younger.
<b>Pair</b>	One adult and one junior from a team.
<b>Team</b>	Composed of 2-6 players and at least one adult and one junior.
