## Step 1 - Scheduling and Planning

	Review the Climate Venue List
	This will help you identify the climate your venue operates in and therefore understand the program delivery and expectations of the number of classes/events you should be running. You can find this in the <b>Planning and Communications</b> page of the Training Hub.
	Use the Template Calendar to Pre-Plan Your Scoring University Program Elements
	Use this resource to plan your program elements across the program year. This will also help you understand when to complete each step by step checklist guide by working backwoods from the recommended implementation stages and you can also link your program elements. The resource is available in the <b>Planning and Communications</b> page of the Training Hub.
	Assess Facility Access
	Ensure you assess access to practice facilities at your venue and discuss the program with your management and coaching team. The access you can get to your facilities and golf courses will influence when you should schedule your program elements and some of the program elements you can offer within your program.
	Decide on the Day and Time of the Themed Classes and Challenge Clubs
	Decide on the day and times you will be running your Themed Classes. We recommend these run on a consistent day and time.
	Decide on the Day and Time of your Scoring University Playing Events
	Decide on the day and time of your monthly Course Play Event. Once again we recommend this is scheduled on a consistent day each month. You should allocate enough time to cover all of the recommended components of the event.
	Schedule your events in GLF. Connect and Review the Training Module - Click Here
	You are now ready to schedule your event on the GLF. Connect system. When doing this, make sure you utilize the specific training module on scheduling your program elements that is available in the Training Hub and Knowledge Base.
